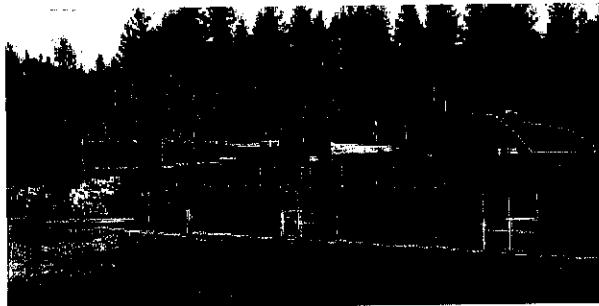
Dear NAWIC Education Foundation,
